Galveston Harbor Tour-March 12



See Galveston Harbor up close aboard Seagull II on the Historic Harbor Tour and Dolphin Watch, Galveston Historic Seaport's 50-foot twin-engine motor vessel. Fast, stable and sheltered, she was built specifically for harbor sight-seeing excursions and is a perfect platform for waterborne experiential learning. The boat is U.S. Coast Guard certified and her operators are fully licensed and knowledgeable about the history and lore of her home waters. Seagull II offers soft drinks and bottled water for sale and has a comfortable main deck, sheltered from sun and rain. An open upper deck affords a full panorama of water and sky. Keep your camera ready for dolphins swimming alongside.

NOTE: Boarding the boat is NOT wheelchair and handicapped accessible.

The pre-paid fee is \$15. The bus will leave OCB at 10 AM and drop off at the pier for a one-hour tour, then we will have lunch at the Shark-Shack. We will arrive back at OCB about 4:00 PM.
